cleaning house. the robins ar-  
coming back  
Sat Mar 7<sup>th</sup> cloudy and wet  
Sun Mar 8<sup>th</sup> clear part of the day and cool  
sprinkled rain in the morning

wet and muddy under foot. Bilton  
was here part of the after noon.  
Tue Mar 10<sup>th</sup> cloudy after noon wet not  
doing much. Shelled some corn for  
the chickens  
Wed Mar 11<sup>th</sup> cloudy and moderate. Bilton  
was here most of the after noon  
Thu Mar 12<sup>th</sup> cloudy and moderate. Mary  
Paul was over. She appears to be  
in great trouble  
Fri Mar 13<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I went over  
to Brother Johns he has been poorly  
for some days. Back. the roads are bad  
Sat Mar 14<sup>th</sup> cloudy and moderate. I transplanted  
a few grape vines. Thomas Bolton  
called to day. So did Bilton and  
Jeremiah Jeffin  
Sun Mar 15<sup>th</sup> cloudy and misty most of the day  
Mon Mar 16<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft. Bilton was  
here part of the after noon. I took  
up part of the apples
