sick with the Scarlet fever. Jennet went right down

27 got a letter from Jennet that Jennie is not dangerous
Dan plowed and scraped part of the cross ditch
in the middle east field

28 Dan went to road and began to dig the potatoes
they are very poor some of them is rotten
