I came by Most Barker, for Toronto plant  
 went to P. D. after dinner & to B. D. this evening  
 for Seed Corn. W. very fine, little showers P. M.  
 28 Boys drew dung I & P & little Anne planted  
 early Potatoes & Hill Corn in root field A. M.  
 I helped Mary dig garden P. M. I & Mary  
 & Mary went to Cedar Grove after supper  
 W. very fine & warm  
 29 Boys finished drawing dung A. M. I helped  
 dig garden H & A cleaned out Colt Stable  
 P. M. A. B. brought Melody & wife from  
 Ohio. to stay to supper W. fine warm  
 I went to Markham P. M.  
 30 Cut Seed Potatoes & I plowed a  
 little sod at other place where we  
 intend to plant some Potatoes A. M.  
 Planted our late Potatoes in root  
 field P. M. W. rainy till about 9  
 A. M. very fine & warm P. M.  
 31 I finished plowing sod & Harrowed it  
 & H. Plowed in Turnip ground A. M. I  
 plowed in root ground I & H & A planted  
 Potatoes on sod at other place than  
 H. A. & Henry washed sheep P. M.  
 W. very fine & warm

Sunday June 1 all went to Meeting  
 at Hebron except P & Susanna  
 remarks & sermon on St John 12  
 24. V. to end of C. by B. C. P. B. M.  
 here P. M. Menno Burkholder's young  
 folks Levi Grove & Fanny Horner  
 at supper Aunt Lisey Burkholder  
 awhile after supper, W. very fine  
 2 I went to Unionville for his  
 road list I plowed H got Frank  
 & Charly shed A. M. we filled 10 bags  
 with Potatoes & 20 bags with O. G.  
 P. M. W. very fine & cool B. M.  
 Albert brought Lisey Rittenhouse  
 & her Brother John & 2 other girls  
 awhile A. M. I got summons  
 to serve as Petal Duron in  
 Toronto on June 10<sup>th</sup>  
 3 H took 45 bus Oats & 10 bags Potatoes  
 to Toronto Oats 42 Potatoes 70¢ per bag  
 I took Susanna to Old Mrs A Burkholder  
 to get cure of liver Complaint I carried  
 Potatoes out of Cellar A plowed I &  
 & I finished planting Potatoes at other place
