- Tue July 19. Fine perfect day, Mr Harrison cleaned pipes and left cellar ones off. I went to Toronto at 3 P.M. and exchanged dress got $3\frac{1}{4}$ yds broadcloth 36 inch 98 cts, 50 cts. I gave .75 cts.
- Wed July 20. Fine bright and cool. Mrs Davidson helping me with dress, fire in Toronto King Street 100,000 lbs. Annie arrived in Toronto. Mrs Delaporte called.
- Thur July 21. Fine bright and cool a perfect day and fine for haying this week, but got such a soaking over week end takes a lot of drying. Annie out here, Hugh. Alice and children called, Mrs Doner called.
- Fri July 22. Thundering and showery in afternoon, heavy rains north of here. J. T. C. pic-nic. I went to Mrs Delaporte for tea at the Bedford Theatre, and home 10 P.M. at Annies.
- Sat July 23. Rained heavily most of day, drizzling in eve - an immense rainfall. Mrs Mason at Annies, first time at Annies for over four weeks.
