- 10 Fine day. Sent a letter to the Toronto News for a copy of Vogue Cook Book for Marion. To 1 doz hiring 25<sup>cts</sup>. Gave Jimmie 8<sup>cts</sup>.  
Ann Hall 1/2 day gave her 40<sup>cts</sup> To 1 gall coal oil 15
- 11 To 4 loaves 24 The weather is fine Prayer Meetings in St Andrew's Church this week
- 12 Another fine day. To 4 lbs butter from factory.
- 13 Dr M Kimmon was here all night and is going today to Lancaster. His place of business is in Nelson B. C. he looks well sowed wheat. 25
- 14 Stormy Murdy went to Cornwall yesterday Fine day. Preaching today Rev A. M Gillivray Toronto preached To 4 loaves 24. 1/2 lb tea 20 Jimmie went with Mrs Crimmon to Councils. The results of the Local Option are disrupted by

- 16 Fine frosty day John and Birdie were down. Rev A Green went to Lancaster to take charge of Red Tarnus people his father is very poorly and had to go and leave and this was his Communion Sunday. Rev A M Gillivray conducted the services here
- 17 Mild day looks like a thaw
- 18 Soft and a few slight showers. Mrs H M Gillis (Charlotte) died yesterday. will be buried tomorrow. Rev. A M G. called for a few minutes. he is looking very well. The S. I convention meets in Lancaster today Jimmie went down
- 19 Charlotte was buried in the new Roman Cemetery at Lancaster. Jimmie and Murdy were down to the burial Jimmie remained to the convention
- 20 To 5 loaves 30<sup>cts</sup> 1 gall coal oil 15<sup>cts</sup> matches 5  
Fine day Murdy went to Alexandria
- 21 Mild. Rain in forenoon. G.P. M rain all day
- 22 To sugar 25 Can salmon 20. Pouring rain  
Mr Mrs W. Whitman and John Clark's daughter were here to tea. I enjoyed their company very much (all the items on the 22 were on the 21) Murdy by steak Allen McDonald Glen. here to dinner. He is working at D.D Grants books with Murdo To 4 loaves I had but 12 cts
- 23 Fine but very slippery. Last night Mrs Gorin and Mrs H Robertson, who is living at Elders, came in and remained until ten. I was cheered by their visit. Not many in church
- 24 Fine mild day. I was out doors last night looking for the comet. but did not see a sign of it. It was seen on Saturday night It began to snow about 8 A.M. I thought it was going to be a regular Burns day. but it cleared up and was fine and bright. had Ann Hall
