Cold day frosty, snow flurries and sunshine at intervals most sunshine. Willie brought up load manure from Steels then we hauled out two from yard and in P.M. 5 or so, all to No 4 W. Bella went down in P.M. she and another going to school concert in J. Hall to-night

We hauled out 4 loads manure to No 4 then Willie fared out and I went down town on wheel got 2 gal coal oil <sup>50</sup> 100 lbs chicken feed <sup>125</sup> and one bag Manitoba flour on the bill at Armstrongs. In P.M. Willie plowed 2 furrow plow in No 4. I went down town at night paid Glen for dust & chop got Oct 29 <sup>1035</sup> got pair rubber boots at Murry's <sup>125</sup> licqponie at Phillips <sup>10</sup>
