- 19 Got at Boies 4 lb steak 7 1/2 lb roast 7 94
 50 ^{cts} brown sugar 50 cts Gram - 1⁰⁰
 Olympians went to Cornwall. Ran went with them. Got Fars. Bill J. Cheyne curbs and sent to Ottawa. Pa came at 4 P. M.
- 20 Professor Ferguson conducted morning & evening services
- 21 Rain in morning. Thunder storm in afternoon. Bird & Hattie. Ran went to see Hattie
- 22 I am always tired being so much on foot
- 23 Ran was called to go to Prescott to play tomorrow. Gave him \$1.40 to get a hat. Jimmie Brown went to Montreal. Pigan 1/2 day
- 24 Rained all day
25. Boys are cutting wheat Pigan 1/2 day
26. Boys went to Lancaster to play lacrosse
