till 2 P.M. then we could all go  
home except those in the Jury  
box. I walked to North Toronto  
& then walked home from Laurel  
Hill. W. fine a little rain. P.M.  
boys drew some Manure of fallow  
& plowed some but the rain  
made it too wet

14 H. Nany & little Annie went to Mark  
ham I & A plowed in fallow A.M.  
they chored & I took 10 bags Peas & barley  
to B<sup>r</sup> D's & got it chopped P.M. W.  
heavy showers P.M.

Dandy 15 I & Nany & little ones went  
to meeting at Altona remarks by B<sup>r</sup>  
C. sermon on by young Saml Hoover  
went to B<sup>r</sup> inlens John Horis to dinner  
& to Simon's to supper W. cloudy  
Dis. Morning. fine today

16 Boys finished <sup>June 1890</sup> drawing dung on fallow  
W. fine

17 I & Nany & little ones went to B<sup>r</sup> in  
law Peter's Boy drew few logs with  
trucks. W. uncommon heavy rains  
went north & some south we did  
not start home till after six P.M.  
did not rain coming home

18 I drew few logs A.M. J. & A  
& B<sup>r</sup> C's Thomas went to 8<sup>th</sup> Con  
Pickering to see the scene of an  
accident on C.P.R. the Stone  
Bridges near Altona was undermined  
with the great Freshet an Engine  
& Van went into the River & five men  
were killed or drowned I Nighswander  
escaped. Duffins Creek was higher  
than it was known to be for years

I went to D. Rerson's A.M. got bag of Corn  
Cracked for hens at B<sup>r</sup> D's P.M. W. fine

19 A plowed fallow I drew logs A.M.  
H. drew P.M. W. fine  
20 Boy wedd. Mangles I & Nany started  
to go to Merkhum. J. H. Ramer's were at  
B<sup>r</sup> C's & said they were coming here
