Very Fine Day Leander to Night Church More Lambs
6th Very Fine Putting out Manure on the Barley Piece
Sowed $4\frac{1}{2}$ of Barley Taking stones of the Wheat Piece

of Wheat put some manure out Fernandez went to

For Jo Douquette Mr Haggarty and Mr Vipond here
Mr Haggarty wanting 25 Bushels of Oats Leander to take
them to him got a Rat made a Bargain with
Mr Vipond for a Raking Machine 22 Dollars
gets 2 years to pay it one Payment Next
March 8th Very Fine East Wind Ploughing Harrowing
Broke the Harrow Taking off stones cleaning and Trimming
the cherries The Drudge came this afternoon Sowed
oats $3\frac{1}{2}$ Leander took to Haggarty 5 Bags of oats took
Down the Stove took the Stove over to the other house
Put up the Curtains Girls went to Jo Douquette with
25 Doz of Eggs and 8 lb of Butter
Rained to night and Thunder and Lightning Burning some
Piles of Brush 9th Fine East Wind Wrote a Letter to Day
Dated the 11th with a for X to send them
Sowed $7\frac{1}{2}$ Bushels of oats Ploughing Harrowing taking
stones of the Wheat ground This is the Day then
to take Peter Skin and Colquhoun Island Went
over to the Bay 10th Ploughing the Potato ground at
the Cherry Tree and Taking Big Stones off of it Eddy Renshaw
her gave him the Letter to put in the office a 1 Dollar
Bill in it Ploughing above the corn ground for corn
Put manure on Potato ground gave Eddy his Buckets Fernandez
crossed took his wheel home Rained all night a calf to Day
Stanley took sick this Evening Thunder

James Cameron Island 11th of May 1901

Ploughing cutting seed Potatoes Last Quarter of the Moon
Rained to Day Mosquitoes Began Shoes 2 Seagoing Vessels
Passed here about 4 o'clock 1 Went West and 1 East got
3 Pikes Rained several showers to Day some Meane smook
Took Carlo away from ^{where} I had him covered till I
could get him taken to a spot which I had
Laid out for him I had not been over where he
Laid to Day and they never told about they
Done so on a Thieving way 12th Rogation Sunday
Rained to night Wind Fine 13th Planted the Potatoes
at the Cherry next the Wheat Ploughing above the
Lane Raining cool 14th Fine Ploughing the corn ground
Ploughed the front of the House and the Tobacco piece
and Back of the House Piled up the Wood at the Big-
oak Tree Took the Leech ashes and put them at the
Maple Trees Burnt some Rubbish Took over 5 Bago
of Oats to Mr Haggarty Stanley Better 15th Fine Day
Ploughing Drilling corn & ground Planted some
of the corn from the House up to the corner of
yard Fence 2 of the Sea Boats went up to Day
Steamer towed a Raft of Logs from Lancaster
to Cornwall Ross Logs & Stanley out to Day
I went Down Round the Lower Point Leander
went to Summerstown took 6 Bags of Oats to
Fernandez went to Lancaster 5 Long Rows and 9
Short ones Took over 5 Tins of Syreph for Mr
Snetsinger Cornwall Working some on the Pier to Day
going to put a Light on it as the talk is that way
Fernandez to Lancaster 16th Ascension Day Holy Thursday
Fine Day Planting corn and Potatoes Putting manure
on the Piece above the Lane Broke the Canoe
William and William Morris here got some
Fish to Day 1 Went up and 1 Went Down of those
Big Boats for the old Country John Mc Rae Poorly
1 More of those Big Boats went up Oriols came
