8. THURSDAY. [342-23]

Thrashing peas all day 5 bushels also some other chores  
& fixing cattle which is always unceremonious Plastering evening

9. FRIDAY. [343-22]

Started to put up two new stalls in cow stable  
got one nearly finished down part of pig pen which was in the way  
& tie poles home from bush.

10. SATURDAY. [344-21]

Michaelmas Term ends.

Forenoon got manger of two stalls made afternoon  
put up other stall finished tie ropes & poles. Got calves tied in next  
root house & year olds into new stalls very busy day. tied cattle with
