- 17. Some rain. not very many in church. Money very poorly since Wednesday  
On Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> 3/2 lb sausage 35. jam bread 24 59  
2.6 butter 60<sup>th</sup> Pullimer 74 bush oats on 18<sup>th</sup>
- 18 Rain since midnight
- 19 Rain all forenoon, Got a letter from Sandus, he is in Syracuse. Mandy went North Doest by 26 bush potatoes. Fair in Alexandria
- 20 Some rain in morning clear in afternoon I was down to Robertsons in evening. Met Miss Bethune of Montreal, and Mrs M Donald spent a very pleasant evening  
3/2 lbs sausage 30 Maggie murchison brought me a fine musk melon yesterday. Pa to Eldr oil 25. Jimmie cough medicine 45.  
Pullimer by 15 bush barley. Thomas McDonald died last night aged 99 years
- 21 Very fine day. Kemp tuned the piano <sup>Murdy</sup> Pa took up some potatoes about 8 bags Murdy at Glen Roy. The stone crusher is at work on Mill square for about 3 days Jimmie took up 3 bags potato
- 22 Another fine day. Pa paid \$20.00 to Murdy for 20 borrowed, 3/2 lbs butter from factory
- 23 Cold an ugly day. Jimmie went in morning for Three Rivers 3/2 lb 3. tea 45 lamp chimney 10  
1 gall coal oil 20. 5 lb mutton 50. 3 lb sausage 30 1. 59
- 24 Fine day a good congregation. Children muddy

- 25 Ann Hall 1/2 day 25. Jimmie came home at Noon
- 26 Fine day Mrs Owen sent a swindler here thinking he was a Japanese patriot and philanthropist 100 =
- 27 Fine day sausage 20 ct. 2 blouse put 5.00

- 28 Very fine day. We got about 30 bush pot atw from Doest, 20 from Pullimer and about 25 of our own. Sophia
- 29 M Luman and her cousin William were here to tea and to spend the evening 70 cake 25 bread 12 chud 39  
Jimmie got at Lancaster 50 flour 1.45 1.45  
Orange meat 25 25
- 30 Lovely day. Raymond put up the we troughs. 1.75 1.75
