Mary Watson. Amie and I for a walk in the evening
fine and milder. Mrs Davidson in the evening.

Thur Apr 21. Draining all afternoon. I went to Toronto. at Dentists. Auntie

Fri Apr 22. A heavy rain last night and all morning then fair but dull.
Willie called in the afternoon.

Sat Apr 23. Poured rain through night. water high and very muddy
no seeding since a week last Thursday. Apr 14. Some are
nearly through but not many. We got our Oak heater.
price \$17.75. the Range went away at \$30.
Amie here in the evening.
