Exceedingly large amount of rain fell last night, raining most of W and at times P.M. not cold. The drainers didn't get any draining done to-day they worked at letting water away from drain dug yesterday measuring drains etc they went home after 4 o'clock P.M. Willie took 6 75 lbs pig chop which Murdy helped us clean down to Charles 35 ts brought up ton shorts and bag bran from Simmons got bread 70ts 36 ct meat Bergins 40^{ts} We chopped some am & threw back mangel to get straw put in to keep them from freezing. P.M. I plowed around drains No 5 Willie went down for chop and 9 more bags bran to complete the half ton. got at Simmons Tea 35^{ts} mustard 15 55 bag sugar 6.60 paid sugar also bran & shorts 36.50 each with chynas R.B. got jinx 30^{ts} stamps 5^{ts} at Phillips. Ground exceedingly wet with rain.
