9:30 this morning.  
men put out Melons  
& Cucumbers. 95  
in the shade again  
today.

June 2<sup>nd</sup> had spraying  
in the morning  
finished old orchard  
took 10 tanks.  
too windy in the  
afternoon and very  
hot again.

planted peppers  
after dinner

June 4<sup>th</sup> still very  
warm 95 again.  
Had Scott around  
offered  $7\frac{1}{2}$  cts for 1000  
crates of Strawberries

June 5<sup>th</sup> still spraying

very warm 97 in the  
shade reported from  
Hamilton. Hottest  
June day since 1840  
June 6<sup>th</sup>. I put on two  
tanks of spray this  
morning. tank went  
on the pump. had to  
take to Coates to get  
repaired. still very  
warm. Strawberries  
crop ruined so that  
and no rain. plants  
are now laying flat  
on the high ground  
have 25 tanks of  
spray on now. will  
take 5 more finished  
put in 5 to 5 1/2 lbs lead  
and 3 1/2 to 3 3/4 gall  
of Lime Sulphur in each  
tank.
