**Treatment of Quinsy.**

Early probing advocated, in order to drain pus accumulation at its inception. With aid of reflected light and tongue depressor, tonsillar fossæ, especially upper ones, are entered in turn by means of a tonsil slitter or probe. Where bottom appears soft, rounded point of instrument is pushed deeper into tissues, capsule pierced, and peritonsillar space entered. The small amount of pus thus evacuated gives a sense of relief and infection stops. This can be carried out in about 8 out of 10 cases. It is practically painless and bloodless.—*Schuster.*
