St Joseph of Ori - a very fine day Mowing
in the Upper Field and the Lower Point
Working at the cellar door Stones Salted the
Cattle with Fine Salt Killed 2 Roosters
Wrote a letter to the Wreta Kennedy Co
Toronto Sissy and Murnie to Summerstown took
Home the Umbrella from Randolph's put
in 2 Loads of Hay from the Upper Field
Made and Gathered 20 coils Leander crossed to
the Social at Chisholms
cranes
a stocking as they always do this time of
year training their young another flock of chickens
28th Very fine very warm N Wind New Beans
Gathering Hay Mowing in the Grove some
choke cherries turning gathering some on the
Lower Point put in Loads Fernandez crossed
29th very fine 3 of them went to the shop
to John Morris Rained to night Thunder
and Lightning 30th Fine Mr Gene came had a
1 lb of Tea Mowing the Grove and around
around the House and Barn Fernandez
and Gene fishing to night got 13 fish
put 3 Bushels of Wheat in the Bags and
Bushels of Corn Gene fixing snood
on his Hooks in the Granery New Potatoes
Moses Lemay here for old Potatoes got
Bushels 31st Fine Windy Mowing
Leander went to Fort Covington to Mill
Mowing below the Corn Sept Day of July
Bought Snaith and scythe 1st of August
SUMMER DAY Fine Mowing south side at
River Mowing on the Lower Point and Weeds at the
Wh Tree went to Fish at Pitt Point got 7 Leander crossed
making coils

MUMMIE'S BIRTH DAY Fine Day W Wind
Mowing Back of the old Garden Mowing
on the Lower Point Gathering and making
Coils in the Grove Gene fixing his Fish
Got some Wire and Rope from him
Began to Rain Cornelius here got 3 lbs
of Butter on credit to pay Saturday or never
3rd Fine put in 2 Loads in the North End of
the Stable Loft Mowing on Lower Point Dull
Mr Gene went to Lancaster for Salt Trammed
the Oak that fell with the Wind at the pile
of Wood Blackbirds playing the Devil with the
Peas and Wheat and oats Beans plenty cherries
near ripe hay not dry enough to put in Raining
every Day Fisherman here for Butter 25 cents
got Salt Sugar Highwines took from Lancaster put the
Highwines in My Balsam Gum Bottle Fernandez
crossed for Mail 3 Gals for Eggs 3 Doz 4th very fine
Harvest Day gathering and putting in 5 Loads
Salted the Cattle Tonia and I to Fish got 37 fish
3 for Eggs got 3 Doz Got a Rat in the Trap Gene
went off these campers got 4 chickens Leander to Day
12 Doz of Eggs 1 Tub of Butter Fernandez crossed
That's 8 Gals sold 5th Fine Rained to night
Thunder and Lightning Fernandez came
6th Randolph's Birth Day The Duke of Edinburgh
BIRTH DAY A Fortunate Day Pulled Down some
of the Logs of the Barn on the North side
Paved the 2 Plates Stanley did Mowing
Back of the old Garden Fernandez to Lancaster
Began the New Potatoes Back of the Barn
and they are good and large the old ones near
done some yet Heavy Rain Thunder and Lightning
Took a Bad fainting Turn to night
