and Seander came 1st of April all Good day

and Doors Got the Horse shed 1 Shoe at
and the Harrows fixed at Dewars
I thing Randolph was with them

DANIEL CAMERON Island 2nd of March 1899
Easter Sunday they said the Sun
Danced this Morning a Fine Day
Randolph came Seander Linn and Tonia
Went to Kenstraws Gordon and
Randolph crossed to church Lots of
Eggs 3rd Fine Day Tapt a good many
to Day Running gathered a Barrel or so
cut the old Marsh hay in two
Hoot some Barrels to the Bush Seander
to the P. Office sent 2 Letters for Medicine
one to New York and 1 to Blumhampton
to Be given free Fernandez and Linnia
went across to Dan Frasers Boys in the
Sugar Bush all Day fixing place for the
Pans I went over to the Pitt Point and
up through the Sugar Bush and up the
Swamp took home the crosscut saw it was
in the swamp Fussy came had a Basket
of Apples 7 lb Dan Frasers Sold 1 pair
of Ducks Brought a Rooster for the 1 we
got in the Fall Seander crossed got the
Pink Pills and 2 Boxes of Bland's or Bland's
Brough some sweet stuff from the Bush 5th
Fine Fine Day Boiling in the Bush went to
the Lower point Fernandez went to Cornwall
a calf and a Lamb Black Ducks
came and Whistlers Black Buds
