to thud tomorrow W. heavy rain
am. Cool Pm ^{D Nighswander} died this morning

22 I threshed W Reesor with
steamers, about 90 Bas Treadwell
& 50 Bas Miscel & over 300 Basley
got done 3 Pm W. fine steady with
wind. short shower. Pm
I & A set up Oat shocks in N E corner field
& Plowed after we were done, H & I helped
to move Machine to Sam Peaves
