Fine day cloudy and sunny hardly freezing. We leveled stones in pig pen floor hauled some boards gravel from house yard over to it then hauled in rest from. I drove down at night to joint meeting of managers and elders in S.S. room. Quarters of systematic giving, individual cups and Mrs Gordon present best with.

Clear sunny day slightly frosty. We took mat of earth out of kitchen cellar put on outside mat back door. In P.M. we cut wood in bush which is almost entirely gone from snow. Girls brought stuff for cleaning silver from beggar peddler 25cts also gave him provisions.

Wednesday

Snow last night. stormy and snowing at intervals to day. frosty. some sunshine. Supt Hamilton called in morning tell us to get up for snow. We finished taking earth out of kitchen cellar etc cut wood cleaned out places with accumulations of tracks. We all drove down at night to supper, Bella stayed at home rest of us went to annual meeting of Melville church got tea there. J. Caldwell and I were elected auditors. They decided to purchase individual cups to cost over \$40. and took voluntary subscriptions there and there. raised almost enough, we gave \$2.00. Mrs Gordon was presented with silver tea set as she has quarrel against. We gave 50cts for it.
