for them at night got Glass
13th Fine 4 of Lewis here for Butter
Leander to church 17th Fine and
Planted the East Potatoes 11
Bushels Sowed the Rease ab
the Lane Harrowing Back to
the Barn made sugar out of
the sap that Run about 2 Hl
of sugar Stanley's Cake adelaide
went to So here Anna and Silly
Wind Leander and Fernandez wet
home with them got some Deco
from Randolph those you have
Blow wind into them have
Thunder and lightning set big eggs to hatch.

Fine cutting seeds Planted Back of
the Barn 8 Bushels of seeds Thunder
fernandez went to Lemay got hay for 3
Hl of Butter 60 Fishing to night with
Dan Spink frost to night 16th Fine
got along Tamrak stick set line
Sowed 7 Bushels of oats next the
potatoes Taking stones out of
Hog Pen Place to make a
garden Pissay and Anna went to
Summerstown with 34 Doz of Eggs
work finished to day Captain
A.J. Baker's First trip down on
Steamer Hamilton
Bought sugar & spools of thread & seeds
17th Fine Turned to Rain East Wind
Planted Rows of Corn stopt
with the Rain Thunder water
raising Rained hard most all night
running the dye for the soap 18th Rain
cleared up Stanley and Leander to kit Wet
cool Leander crossed setting the water run
19th Fine Windy East Wind 20th Fine Day
Rogation Sunday Randolph and adelaide here
John & Gordon Spink Bob Summers Rose here
Pissay and Anna went to his pens house rain to day
Randolph took the Bycle
