Fine sunny morning clouded over by noon rained at intervals P.M. We dug out obstructed tile in drain near O.A.R. No 5 and got out a muskrat we then cultivated and harrowed in No 5 S.W. till noon P.M. Willie drove down for crop at mill 42 cts got 2 bags bran @ 2.70 bushel corn 20 cts I brought disk harrow over to No 5 got wet doing so did not hitch up again worked at movable pig pen. Mrs Mackie over with Rhubarb and duck eggs we let the sow out of pig pen also the stable one and the latter fouled the former so badly that it can hardly walk.
