- 23. Our boy lost at last night's game. One of our best players, Easley M. Judge, could not go. he is sick with grip and a little Sullivan boy played in his place

- 26. Muddy got home this 10 A.M. Jimmie went to Alexandria to a Conservative meeting. Muddy 3 loaves
- 27. Rain not many in church
- 28. Jimmie left today for Cornwall to take the 5 o'clock train for Ottawa to be at the supper of the Soldiers of South African fame. The generosity was on the 27th Tardeburgh 19 years after Majuba Hill

- 3. Fine day. Muddy 4 lbs butter, 70 coal oil 15
- 4. Very fine day. looks if all the snow would go Mrs Pt Thomas paid \$3.00 of rent 3 loaves 18. 0 - 18 70 1 lb tea 30 matches 5
- 5. Dull day looks snow 10 A.M. Now 2 P.M. lovely sunshine and the roads taking a hard one 70 sugar 25 molasses 20
- 6. Very fine day. No preaching. the minister has gone to Martintown for the opening of the church
- 7. Rain all last night with lightning and thunder 70 rooled wheat 25. 10 ct
- 8. A change in the weather. It turned cold and stormy
- 9. Fine day. Jimmie drawing wood from east farm. Hockey in Cornwall to night. the boys went
- 10. Drawing wood. has old sawmill boy and team swamping over the creek. One from cheque
- 11. Very bright still at the wood. 70 4 lbs corn meal 4
- 12. Muddy has a very bad cold. Our team won the game in Cornwall on the 9th, 70 1 lb maccam 10 1 gall coal oil 20. 4 francs - 2 of them yesterday
- 13. Fine day
- 14. I have a cold since Friday
- 24. I went to bed early night Monday 14th. and did not come down to stay, until yesterday. Jimmie had a cold and had to remain in the house to look after me
