- 1 Wednesday Lent will expire with this week
- 2 I was not at Prayer Meeting I was at Committee
- 3 Andrew Barrett, Nov. died yesterday, he was crushed by a tree falling on him, as he was cutting timber on his farm Saturday March 28th. he will be buried tomorrow. It began to snow this evening, it was very cold and windy in the morning
- 4 Snowed all night and still snowing and storming, but not cold Ray is sick and I have to do his work Aunt Annie is sick and Bird is with her
- 5 Still snowing we have a drift at the kitchen door that is about 4 feet high
- 6 Mr & Neil Wm walked on snowshoes to Lancaster for the mail
- 7 Fine day but not a sleigh on the road Only one sleigh at Church Sandy O's he had Lutch, Burgess led the men
- 8 Rained last night snowed today scarcely a sleigh on the road
- 9 I am not well Ray is a little better Pa has not been out for three days
- 10 Pelous came to the farm on Friday
- 11 6 P.M. The morning was beautiful fine sunshine, snow thawing fast but now it looks like rain
- 12 Far went to the Grove to go to Cornwall tonight to a St Andrews concert
- 13 It did last night and is raining today
- 14 Pa got 4 Lemons 10 cts
