directly to the skin, I take pains to shave the hair. I am sure that this rule is not generally observed—a breach that causes the patient acute suffering upon removal, owing to the rich nerve supply of the hair follicles. Where the hair grows out thick and stubby, as from the scalp and beard, the part must be shaved or the plaster will not adhere. Such brutal depilation causes the patient to complain bitterly, and leaves minute wounds of the hair follicles, which invite bacteria and may result in furuncles.—Dr. P. G. Skillern, Jr.; Pa. Med.
