Miller and Charlie helped all day.  
Vernon took a fat calf to Elmira this p.m.

17 Saturday. Fair with cold wind  
Walter went to Alma this a.m. and  
took Dave, the horse he sold up to  
Alex Borrooy. Sam Horst had our team  
to go to Elmira. Vernon drew wood home  
from the bush. Charlie Miller called
