Mowing on the Iowa Point Grade 50 coils Fine
not very well Windy cold some 8th Rainning
Windy Fernandez started for summertown and
Turnell Brock took all the apples off the tree
Leander cut Otter root with the depth yesterday
Ducks not plenty shelling some Beans 10st
Yesterday in the Morning 9 Leander to Hamilton
for the Papers Houghin and Gorria to see Piggy Bay
Windy Fine Line Boat Passport went down this Morning
Sniped yesterday 10th Went to the Bush Fernandez and I to
make a Tortoise just in time long took in some Beans
and corn growing very well with so much Rain. 11th
Fine Day Went to Cornington sold 2 Yards of Blue
to a Kid paid the molly place $\frac{2}{5}$ got on credit Bought
150 lbs of flour 4^{1/2} lbs shorts 140 lbs Tea 3 lbs Pepper 31
Matches 10 lbs Paper 150 Japies 5 cash 82 sold to Mr.
John Gyo 24 lbs of Tobacco 72 Bought Stanley Boots 2 Dols.
Dove him 20 cents on the 13 oots Bought Boots 2 50
Poroder 40 Shot 10 Bought 3 Butter 10 lbs 60 Boots for
Linen 1 25 Calico Face 10 1/2th Mowing Fine Rain Thunder
Drew the brought from the Bush 13th some Rain Fine
Cold Mowing Shelling Beans 14th Holy Cross Fine
Lord Starkey 1 went Down on Steamer Passed
Shutting in hay sticks all full shot 2 Ducks & 5
Squitting hay & Wind Mowing Drew some road
at a Road in the upper field Frank Leplanche
got a Note for Pay from Summerly Leander
closed for the Mail 16th Rainning 17th Gordon here
mowing & Wind Mr. Gence here Brought 100 lbs
apples his hand very bad Mrs. Kelly at the
fisherman's 18th & 19th Gence went to Corinwall
Mowing in the upper field shelling Beans

Fine Day Mowing in the upper field got Honey
from Phillip to pay his account at Whilshammas
Philip went off to Dr. Lucy the Indian here
gave him a Pipe Model 20 coils in Lower Field
20th Rainning hard cutting cornstalks and took in all the
corn husked it seen something like Wild Geese or Gulls 8
of them Fine boiled Blackbirds come 21st Still raining very
heavy Rain began to put the felt on the house & wind
22nd First Day of Autumn & fine Day East Wind 3
Men here Demo Rodney Briggs and Oliver Streeted me
with very good hickory and cedar gave them some
matches Fernandez went to Schummers town Bought
of Schummers Bread for Fishermen Bought of Mcleod
Vine 5 cents did not get my papers looks like
a fire in Lancaster to night putting felt on
the house put a beam in the floor of the house
23rd East Wind Fine Bismarck came had a basket of apples
^{seen by Gence} took a shot to make & give him a basket of Butternuts
Fernandez and I to the Kit Kit 24th Fine began
the big Pen taken in Hay putting on the Barn
Floor the Boys Fishing with Hambeau got 3
25th at the Day Fine Days Putting on Hay drew we
got out Drew some sticks for the big Pen
gives in here now a good deal of shooting to
the south shore 26th Fine cutting hay in the
Brush at the wet place made 20 coils of hay some
apples Fernandez Fishing got 20 bunches put in
the cornstalks shot at duck did not get them
Black cherries 100 lbs at the Pen Blossom on Strawberries
27th High West Wind Rainning hard fine 13th Hemispherical
butternuts falling working at the big Pen gathering more
beans top of the stack 28th at the Pen put on
the pigs in it
