we Jess all by stamps total 72 got bread at Fols 14 cts 20

he brought up 7 & M. I cleaned cellar Jc. P.M. 14

we thrashed flax. Willie drove girls down in cutter

89 to Magwood in route to town came back took 7 & M

down in buggy brought up girls again they got meat

at Shortneeds 55 cts. Andrew skins got paid skin with 1/2 calf. 55

Willie sold sheep skin to Keener \$1.40 1.40

Thursday

Cloudy, raining some A.M. snowing some P.M.

got colder and windy. We thrashed flax

another sheep had a lamb to-day. Willie took cream

down to Russell's in morning got bread 7 cts. 7

Beatty Skrook in looking at our stock in evening.

I drove the girls over to Rutherford's we got tea

there and spent the evening.

a little snow last night. stormy day frosty

sunny & cloudy. We finished thrashing the flax

a sheep had 3 lambs to-day Willie trimmed

turnips. Mary at women's meeting at Mrs Barbours.

Saturday

Sunny and cloudy frosty. I spread load

of manure sand till A.M. Willie drove down 2 02
