 Very frosty day. Sunny. We got 3 loads turnips down today finishing barn floor ones. Willie got tickets 80cts got cheque from Schario for his in full \$59.90 Willie drove one down in evening to Sunday School Convention meeting held in St Andrews church He got 2 stamps 4cts

5 Thursday
 Mostly cloudy, chilly frosty. We hauled in
