Looked like rain to day did rain some at noon rained very heavy at night and nearly all night a splendid rain very much needed thunder and lightning. Alex Mc Kee hoing all day we hoed most of mangels second time also thinned upper half of last 20 rows turneps. Peter Clark got load of fuel and heavy waggie to take some wood for Mrs Duarrie used her horse also. I went down town at night drove father down who was up in P.M. I paid J.C. Chapman on fuel for guards got 9th also slats for loader \$2.50 for ten got from C. Mathani receipt for 2 tons coal to be got by Dec paid him \$13.00 paid Hartman for meat got June 24th 55cts paid Matt Armstrong for oak table \$4.50 got at Merris on c/c quilt & patch 15cts. Mrs Geo Merris came from B.C. this week
