Frosty stormy and sunny I spread the F Armstrong load manure and two more from stable at I.S. Willie drove girls down in P M got at Phillips, bottle S. Canstic Balsam \$1.50 hooks and eyes 2 cts. I went down at night got at Phillips 6 bolts 6 cts at Mannis 4 bolts 12 cts. Belle stayed down.
