When we got back we took Juan off and put Belle on and took the place out to Evans as he wanted it to fit the sleds on that he made for us, he also sharpened a caulter. It was the old place Dad plowed all day with the sleds. Sam Thompson came over with his five ewes this afternoon and put them in with our flock. Cold wind but nice day.

Sunday November 12<sup>th</sup>

Frank and I went down to Sunday school & church but none of the rest came down. Dick was over to dinner I drove him down town this afternoon and then took Cash down to Uncle West's to see Aunt Mary. In night I spent church hour with Mary as I knew she had a bad cold and would be here and that the family would be at church she wouldn't let me stay after so I sat in the back with Clark for a couple of hours and called in to see family on my way home. Cloudy and a raw cold wind all day.

Monday November 13<sup>th</sup>

Dad plowed all day. I raked the lawn this morning. This afternoon Frank and I took his ducks down to ship to Silverwood's also took

the geese back to Al. Faulkner all but one, Frank's share and got some more of the locust wood at Aunt's. Dad went down to see Henry to night. Cold all day. Quite a snow storm this afternoon to night.

Tuesday November 14<sup>th</sup>

The ground being covered with snow to day Dad didn't plow but we did move the straw stack in so that we could let the cows in the yard. Cold, raw, cloudy, snowed a little.

Wednesday November 15<sup>th</sup>

Frank and I got our butter milk this morning and this afternoon went down and got some chicken feed at the mill and went on down town. Dad just did chores. I took my horse down to the mill to night to fix. It has been freezing all day in the shade & cold enough for meat.

Thursday November 16<sup>th</sup>

We just did chores to day. Eva went down to her mother's this afternoon and the baby and I drove after her during a heavy snow storm. Art Quabury got his heifer this morning. It has been milder to day but snowed all night.
