A fine sunny day thawing in sun slighting pretty nearly gone. I went to school meeting in A.M. acted as auditor with J. Sanderson. Willie walked over Armstrongs and Fords Sarafaxa farms. In P.M. we got back 3 loads manure. J. Chapman and Mr Mc Murry in in P.M. trying to sell us manure spreader. Mary and Marthy Bowley collecting for B.S. in P.M. I got institute ticket from J. Sanderson 25cts got from Mrs Quarrie on Xmas goods for 3 planks

Willie took the 10 bags potatoes we sold to Mr Rowe on 14th down to him also some straw to J. Graham and brought up from there and load manure spent it on No 5 S then we brought up load wood from bush. Mary drove down in P.M. brought up mother. She got at Phillips liquorice 15cts Xmas card and stamps 12cts dry goods in Pattens 10cts letter stamps 2 Willie sent away on Saturday papers for registration of Judith to Ottawa for \$1.25 postage & express 3

Raining to-day cloudy snowing some in P.M. frost at night. We made some of porch for side overunda picked over turnips etc. from Knox up for dinner. Willie drove down in P.M. got Lucy shod 25cts goose at Pattens 99 nails & 5 empty pounds at Mannies. He went to cold storage in A.M. also to Schain on selling hogs.
