I settled up with him to-night and paid him off, all but about three dollars. Our friend E. D. came last night to see us and stayed with us all night.

Have just been passing through another dark season but God sustains me.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 26, 1870.

Charles keeps on ploughing still. I have been busy to day at different errand jobs. I went to the town this afternoon where I went out to the town line to pay a debt which I owed there.

Strange things have taken place to day. No ray Christian experience. Something seemed to ask me why I did not trust in the Lord at His word with reference to the matter of a Companion, and to say also, that my heart's desire should not be accomplished if I offer all the thought that I have up it, and a temptation to sin.
