was by the front gate. Pot 1 box crackers 25 25

- 9 A fine day I was busy 3 lb steak 30 30
- 10 I was in church. D. J. Fraser had a baby  
christened. Margaret
- 11 Had Harriet sp day washing 25. Got 1  
box saddle powder 15 cts - 14 lbs beef 96 96
- 12 The first day of fair Missie Clark  
came to see us
