Very hard frost last night fine sunny day
we brought over load hay from other barn
took back load manure 7 L then brought
home load bad turnips and some straw

in pit with Lucy. We have 8 lambs to-date.

Thursday

Frost last night sunny day cool wind.
I went to Parkers in morning got cart
bought at Sherwoods sale then we hauled back
two loads manure to 7 L. In PM Willie
harrowed No 7. Mother up in PM Mary drove
her down took 12 lbs butter to Mrs Mc Vicars. Father
brought up some shrubs in wheelbarrow. 4 more lambs.

Frost last night cold day cloudy snowing at
intervals in PM. I hauled back 2 loads manure 7 L
in AM. Willie cultivated in No 7 in PM. We weighed
cattle to-day as follows White steer 1100 Little 1000
BBawler 960 BBW before 885 Sir Julian 890 Black Hen 970
Judith 670 Mc Kee ster 5' 90, I went up to brightons in PM no fence
