We got pay for the July milk 10.00 11.25 was
what it came to, ~~40.00 for 500 lbs~~

25 Thursday. I was sick all night with head
ache, but am up, knitted a pair in a
stocking. Got 2 1/2 lbs butter 50 50

26 Slept but little last night, made
a visit for Jimie today. It rained
all day yesterday the meadow was
flooded

27 Am a little better

28 I was not well enough for Chr

29 Very fine day Got 14 lb butter from

30 Down special at D. H. McTigue
S. B. ^{blind night} all there but myself & Jimie
Gave Ram, 25 cts. Put in all the grain but ^{Black} wheat

31 Fine bright now, rain in morning
