10 I & Penman & Benjamin brought home ewes from
B. C. AM. Took Chop grain to B. S. P.M.
W. mild. Cloudy, sleighing good
11 Joe drew 2 loads Pine wood to Markham I shelled
grain Corn AM I & Nancy went to Whitewater P.M. W. mild

17 Finished Threshing. about 100 bus more Fall wheat &
some 400 bus Oats W. very very Cold below from
West Calmed down towards night eat done in
good time. Machine on splendid both days
18 I & John & Glavin went to Whitewater AM Joe done
