Allan took back small bread manure to find wheat took 6 bags over to pro Hamilton for oats and brought home load wood all in sleigh. In PM Willie and I drove down town with Jennie in cutter got turnip money from Jim Beattie 24.22 paid taxes for 1904 at Sulph bank 28.20 got Kettle mended at D. Webster 30 loaf bread at 7cts 12 Received from Auntie for butter 34 Gave father cheque for \$1.00 to pay on Dams note.
