white frost last night a few flakes

19 Henry went to Pickering with Thomas's Man
to buy some Cement for Flavin's new stable
Thomas is cementing his Hopper floor but
there was not enough Cement therefore both
floors so Henry brought half of the load
for Thomas. They got home after dinner
P. J. & I picked apples & Chored the corn
in a lot of Corn P. M. I brought home
a load of Chop A. M. & 1 P. M. with Mone
Bonnie she is not so very lame now
W. fine & clear but very cold & strong
N. W. wind. Calm this evening
Monday 20 at home P. J. & I were here to dinner
W. rather cloudy A. M. Clear & Cool P. M.

21 Henry helped Johnny Revere to Wreck
to drive a load of wood out of P. J.
back for A. B. this morning then he & a drive
wood into woodshed all day W. fine
Celine & Mary went to Mankhan P. M.
I & Henry & Anna went to King Beach
Cahill P. M. very fine & clear day
22 Henry went to help run Machine in
Delos Reason's place at Rauch's &
helped Johnny Reason's thresh A. M. &
helped P. J. & I P. M. I finished ganging
A. M. he made about 40 gal. Cider at
Lapp's P. M. Alf Jackson & another boy
began painting Hebron Meeting house
today I took Susanna to P. J.'s this

home at night Chop home W. fine
clear & warm a little Cloud this morning
23 I helped P. J. & I thresh till about 3 P. M.
then rolled the Corn ground to break the stubs
then he began to single plow it south of back

Susanna home from P. J.'s this evening W. warm
very strong West wind. Calm this evening
24 Henry Plowed P. J. & I top soil through A. M.

Lamin' Bee today Hevman's were here too
W. fine & clear sharp N. W. wind
Jackson & his boy finished first coat at meeting
house today they did not paint yesterday
