Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> cold  
 J.W. & Father chored & went to school meeting in morning. The vote was 8 & 11 in favor of the section joining the consolidated school. in afternoon I went to mill for grist. paid account \$10<sup>00</sup>  
 paid Dr Savage's bill \$16<sup>75</sup>  
 pd for chopping. 45<sup>c</sup>  
 got 500 bran at Goldie  
 x Kyma. 3 bred to Prince of Benton

Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 1903  
 We chored around barn. and Father & J. sorted apples in afternoon. Mary Children & I went to Dorn's in afternoon had quite a pleasant time  
 Oct 8 x we bred No 1 to Prince of Benton,

 J.W. hauled wood in morning & started Turnips. hauled five loads. got 50<sup>lb</sup> of sugar from Precious on account of wood. Bessie Mountain came today on her way to Goldstone.
