To Preserve Urine.

About six or eight drops of chloroform are added to each fluid ounce and the mixture well shaken. The excess of chloroform soon collects at the bottom of the bottle. Samples so treated will keep for months, even in the hottest weather. Chloroform promptly reduces Fehling's solution. If, therefore, it is desired to test for sugar, the chloroform must be removed by boiling the liquid; or, better still, the bismuth or phenylhydrazin test must be used. Chloroform does not interfere with these nor simulate sugar.—*Medical Summary.*
