7 Sunday. Mild and drizzly. We went to church & S. S. this f.m. Geo. Schneider died this morning.

8 Monday. Fine mild day. Walter took some little pigs to Elmira this morning and butchered one of Dad Schneider's pigs this afternoon. Vernon spent the evening at Wesley Miller's.
