 Tying the Sail 11<sup>th</sup> Randolph to Livingston  
 got his hair cut 2 men Drowned Stewart  
 and Sava on the 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday morning found  
 the Boat Bottom side up Bought Cotton 3.50  
 on Credit (Tea 1 Dollar Paid) Bismarck  
 Came home Washing the Wool 12<sup>th</sup> and  
 Went home with Hamiltons Boat  
 William Dene <sup>put out Tobacco</sup> on <sup>London</sup> Clame  
 Brought <sup>careful</sup> <sup>Phillip</sup> <sup>came</sup> <sup>to</sup> <sup>the</sup> <sup>market</sup> <sup>clothes</sup>  
 Bought a Ward Soap 1 Bar 02 per  
 13<sup>th</sup> Raining Blowing What Sunday  
 14<sup>th</sup> Raining at Potatoes Heard  
 that Sava Drowned Stewart  
 I thought so or talked about as  
 Sava is a Bad character and Stewart  
 had a lot of money on him 14<sup>th</sup>  
 Pickles son here for sand gave me  
 a Dollar Raining Cutting hay for the  
 2 Bulls at Potatoes Killing Greeds  
 Heard these men were found 15<sup>th</sup> at Potatoes  
 16<sup>th</sup> Randolph and Bismarck to F Coyn  
 Sold Tennet of Butter Paid for the Melon  
 Cotton Bought 100 of Flour 2.50 2 Tennets 50  
 Brought 22 cents Cash home Rained here  
 got 15 cents for Butter 17<sup>th</sup> Tore down the  
 Cook house 18<sup>th</sup> The Ever memorable Battle  
 of Waterloo at the Cook house 19<sup>th</sup> Work  
 at the Cook house Randolph and Bismarck  
 crossed for nails 10 lb 40 Thread 5 20<sup>th</sup>  
 Fine Day Randolph crossed to Plum Island seen  
 one of the cattle with a cut in her  
 21<sup>st</sup> that day of summer Bismarck and J  
 crossed Bought a In Ward soap & salt 80 on  
 credit Pepper paid got 25 from Randolph

1st Day Summer brought the Fishermen 1000 Flour 2 1/2  
 4 1/2 lbs of Fine Salt 1/4 Spoonful 5 Ran. Dolph got  
 a Lunge 22" Fixing Floor in the Cook house  
 Warm set a Line Weeding Potatoes and Beans  
 2<sup>nd</sup> 27 Fishermen & boys went of to night put  
 the Plough through some of the Potatoes 2 1/2  
 St John the Baptist Day Corpus Christi  
 Fixing a door on East end of the Cook house  
 Taking up Randolphs Line 3 Kattmen  
 here Looking for Timber had a stick of  
 Elm with them 25" Raining 26" Raining  
 Angus & James and John and Allen here  
 gave them a Juppy Dog Fernandez  
 sold his Perch to them Raining Thunder  
 and Lightning Ran. Dolph and Brammarch  
 Cropped for the Macle & Hamilton way  
 at the Mill of 30 Lays and came down with  
 the Fisherman 27" of Rain Procession Sunday  
 Raining Thunder 28" Randolph Cut his  
 Foot Ploughing Potatoes at the Apple tree  
 Working at the front Door of the Cook house  
 2 men shooting Ducks had a Dog  
 Randolph Drove them away Weeding  
 Potatoes in upper field Fine Day 29<sup>th</sup>  
 St Peter & St Paul Cannons shooting  
 Back the way a Williamstown Windy West  
 and changed to high North Wind Weeding Beans  
 Northern Lights or Merry Dancers to night and  
 they are dancing Took a big stone out of the ground  
 before the Door Keeping in the Bulls 30<sup>th</sup> Cropped to  
 Summerston <sup>I sayles here put sheep on hills</sup> brought of the cholera Match 10 Hocks 2  
 1<sup>st</sup> of July Dominion Day a Great Day in Cornwall  
 Brammarch cropped to the Ric Neat Hamiltons  
 Mrs Chicholm Brought his cloths there Sunday school  
 scholars 2<sup>nd</sup> at Potatoes and Potato Bugs one of the  
 sheep Came 30<sup>th</sup> Set out the 2 Bulls
