 finally decided to do it at 55 to road and  
 refund \$45. for destruction of crops. P.M. I  
 drove Bella down we went to Mrs J.C.  
 Richardson's funeral Bella got at Phillips  
 hair oil 40cts at Mann's paint and lamp \$1.05  
 goods at Russell's on dc. I got Cuzzey fixed  
 at Gilbons 5cts ordered coal at Nichols  
 2 tons sent paid for it \$14.70 gave cream chyege  
 part payment. Willie disked and harrowed  
 rest of turnip land and I sowed phosphate on  
 it after tea. I dropped 3 kinds a sheep died to-day.

 the pile wood up. Willie took Kate to  
 Rogersons at night unless I filled up the  
 refuse hole I dug at driving shed in spring  
 had it nearly full. I planted some potatoes in Wooded.
