Very heavy steady rain last night - also thunder and lightning. Cloudy and sunny day very warm. We thrashed this AM we got tank filled at barn spout last night we had following hands Mr Maywood Mr Pick D. Allen D. Skunk Bob Lindale J. Ford J. Dix. We thrashed all the oats that were in and nearly all the barley. Arthur Walker took his outfit to Rogersville at noon. To PM walked up in morning. Willie drove them down in evening. Sam Mc Kee brought meat this morning. I raffled mangels P.M. Willie raked barley field No 2 and we brought in raking. R.D. up at noon went down again May got 25 bushel apples from Mrs Bondy yesterday 25cts I stopped a little batteries just working.

Thursday

Raining nearly all day heavy and steady Wet weather now. Willie took cream dinner to Russell's in morning. We did inside work - dry chopped pig & horse cleaned up boxes of bolts nails etc. Willie and Mary drove up to see cattle at Allens P.M.

Friday

Cloudy morning cleared off sunny. I found out 5 furrows and plowed in No 4 barn field sod J. Jameson over in morning to tell us our horses were in grain field he put them out. Willie drove girls down P.M. they called on Mrs Mrs Mrs Clark she was not at home they called on Mrs Rutherford. They paid Mr Thompson for wall paper
