thunder and lightning. Cloudy and sunny day
very warm. We thrashed this A.M. we
got tank filled at barn about last night
we had following hands w^m Maywood
Mr Pick D. Allen: I think Bob Lindale J. Ford
J. Dix. We thrashed all the oats that were in
and nearly all the barley. Mother Walker
took his outfit to Rogmans at noon. Tom
walked up in morning. Willie drove them down
in evening. Sam Mc. Kee brought meat this
morning. I ruffed mangels N.D. P.M. Willie
raked barley field No 2 and we brought in raking.
N.D. up at noon and down again May got
25 basket apples from Mrs Bowley yesterday 25/5
I dropped a little batteries just working.

Thursday

Raining nearly all day heavy and steady
Wet weather now. Willie took cream down
to Russells in morning. We did inside work to-
day chopped pig & horse cleaned up boxes
of bolts nails etc. Willie and May drove
up to see cattle at Allens P.M.

21

Friday

Cloudy morning cleared off sunny. I firmed
out 5 furrows and plowed, in No 6 barn field sod
J. Jamison over in morning to tell us our horses were in grain
field he put them out. Willie drove girls down P.M. they called
on Mrs Jess Clark she was not at home they called on Mrs
Rutherford. They paid w^m Thompson for wall paper
