S & I up all day (he came up for breakfast and
intends to do so now) also Stanley S & I turned
turnips 9 AM spread loads & turned 1 PM I
scuffled New Orchard turnips 9 AM. Willie
cut rest of 72 field and raked yesterday
cut. We got 8 loads hay in to day from
72 all loader loads.

Wednesday

Another very hot day mostly sunny. S & I
up till nine AM when J. C. Tompkins came up to get
him go down to help him with his paper he got back
here about 11 AM after dinner he went to work
Bouleys rearing. Stanley up all day. Willie
took cream down in morning got at Bergins
meat 55 ds got at mill pig feed \$5.80 also
paid for last chop 31 ds all by cheque on R B.
he got at Russells goods 53 ds. Willie cut some
hay in No 7 other side barn I & S Raked rest
of 72 field and we brought over load at noon
PM we finished 72 field except raskings
5 loads to other barn and 2 to this one making 36 loads
108 Willie brought mother up she is staying all night
Wm Clark up got eggs 58 ds

and some potatoes PM we got in 6 loads hay 5 of them
