Abstract of letter from Dr. José de la Vega—Continued.

Her general condition was as follows: A very marked anemia, the mucous membranes extremely pale; she had been suffering for some eight or ten days with a persistent headache and buzzing in the ears; palpitation and great debility, somewhat marked edema in the lower extremities; irregular menstruation. She had a great aversion to taking any nourishment, frequent vomiting with sometimes intense gastric pains.
