- 3 very hot no water to wash we got our cistern patched yesterday by Cameron he is working at Gudbo's We had a letter from Ranjild Campbell, he is in Texas, and has been poorly for more than 3 years. sowed beets & mangolds
- 4 Still hot and dry. I am working at birds polinaise
- 5 Thursday very hot and dry 2 lb rice 1/2 <sup>may 25</sup>
- 6 Saturday Friday a Temperance social last night, 25 cts a ticket - Pa, Murky Bird & Ran, were there began to make a coat for Ran.
- 7 very hot bucked in oven got a bit of stick yesterday 12 cts for lb
- 8 Hot Hot 85 in the shade Uncle Don wife and Far, and Mame were here
- 9 Had a letter from Far. Alish M German brought it to Lancaster Far is well A Temperance Meeting at Clark's S. Hom M. Galloway, Burgess & Charley M Donald each took a load
- 10 Had another letter from Far one written on the 22 of May. Pa is ploughing & sowing the valley lot putting in beens Pagon is ploughing it with our horses Bot. 1 bush of poor beens from John Bush

- 11 Looks like rain I was sick all day
- 12 Rained in the night I am better today P.M. had a good deal of rain. It is three weeks today since we had rain Bought at Dan McDonalds on the 10th 8 yds of catco for one 12 1/2 = 100. 4 yds for 100 Marion 11 cts = 44. 2 yds cotton 10 = 20 1 spool 7. 71
- 14 Nice day Jimie is pretty well he thought to go to Cornwall today but the wind is too high. There was a horrible murder committed within two miles of Chesterville on the a kind of a weak minded man killed a woman with an axe thinking it was a goat
- 15 nice day grand procession in the village
- 16 Jimie & I went to Cornwall today lots of people from our neighbourhood were there I did not buy anything
- 17 very hot, I washed
- 18 hot hot I did not go to prayer meeting
- 19 Pa & Jimie were in Lancaster, Jimie got a felt hat - 1.40. 1 box pins 20
- 20 Pa went to Lancaster got cloth to make a suit for himself about 21.19.00. he took \$12.5 from Pa
- 21 D. H. M. German was here today he saw Far on Sunday. he was well Pa & Jimie went to Lancaster to
