- April 1 The Rev. Govee at the Village Sunday  
2 The Rev. Mr. Feltwell preached in the schoolhouse  
3 Fine morning  
4 Paper given at the Station very much  
done. Govee took a horse to intend to go  
to the track tomorrow morning  
5 B. Govee went away on the morning Express per Montreal  
I did not give the books to Chapin we did  
7 I went to John McCormick to get him to help me  
to fill up the financial & statistical blanks of the Church  
Gordy Chapin was at the house  
8 fixed benches for the fence at the Church  
9 The Rev. Mr. Cochran preached in the schoolhouse  
he came here from Quebec he is student from <sup>College</sup> Montreal  
10 began to put up the fence at the Church fine day  
rain 11 heavy rain last night & most of the day  
cleaned up the Barley put away 4 bushel for seed  
cleaned up the wheat had 11 bushel went to a raiser of  
Benj. Youngs in the afternoon  
12 went to Goulogue to the mill took 5 bushel of wheat  
& nearly 6 of barley the roads is very bad  
13 worked at the fence  
14 do do drew some rails from the Barn  
yard & home  
15 finished the fence all but 13 rails we drew rails  
from the northeast field where Mr. Thomas split  
them last fall. Gordy went to N. Kendricks for  
ten bushel of wheat that I bought of him gave  
him one dollar & twenty five cents per bushel  
The Rev. Mr. Cochran preached in the schoolhouse  
16 began to plow - plowed in center part next  
the road south half the ground south west  
17 plow in some fields  
do do some a little rain  
rain 11 do this plow the ground is getting a little drier
